## AMBASSADOR W. ROBERT KOHORST (RET.)



2021 Good Character Gala Honoree

W. Robert Kohorst served as the U.S. Ambassador to the Republic of Croatia from 2018 to 2021. At the conclusion of his term, the President of Croatia, with the concurrence of the Prime Minister and the Minister of Foreign Affairs, presented Ambassador Kohorst with the Order of Duke Branimir medal for excellence in promoting international relations.

Prior to his service in Croatia, Ambassador Kohorst was the founder and CEO of Everest Properties, based in Pasadena, California, and currently is an advisor to the company.

From 1984 through 1990, Ambassador Kohorst was the President of the Private Placement Group for Public Storage, Inc., a national U.S. real estate syndicator.

In 1990, Ambassador Kohorst became the Chief Executive Officer and principal of two businesses, Tiger Shark Golf, Inc., a golf equipment manufacturer, and Masquerade International, Inc., a manufacturer of Halloween costumes.

Ambassador Kohorst holds a B.S. in accounting from the University of Dayton (Summa cum Laude) and a J.D. from the University of Michigan Law School (Order of the Coif). Following law school, he was a law clerk for Judge Albert Engel, U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals.

Ambassador Kohorst has been recognized for his contributions to public service organizations and education as Director and past Chairman of the Young Presidents' Organization (San Gabriel Valley Chapter), Regent of Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles, California, Trustee of La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. Ambassador Kohorst served as past President of the San Gabriel Valley Council, Boy Scouts of America and has remained engaged with Scouting in the Greater Los Angeles Area Council, Boy Scouts of America.

Ambassador Kohorst is married to Shelley Allen, a graduate of Central Michigan University with a degree in education. They have two adult sons, Kevin and Matt both of whom work at Everest Properties. Bob and Shelley have two grandchildren, William and Charlotte, ages 8 and 6. The entire family is passionate about sports, particularly skiing, basketball, football, baseball, tennis, soccer and golf.


## ANDREW CUSTODIA
